


Community Platform -One- stop- shop





Submission process and funding overview (1st Open Call)

All proposals must be submitted exclusively via the MANTRA platform, which is the sole authorised channel for applications.

Submissions received after the deadline (15 September 2025) will not be considered under any circumstances.

Once submitted, applications cannot be altered or resubmitted

Each selected project will run for a period of six months

This 1st Call has a maximum allocated budget of 1.250.000 € aimed at supporting a maximum of 25 SMEs in the execution of their MANTRA Journey Plan


